"In the summer of 2024, the Balourdet Quartet will return to Green Mountain Chamber Music Festival for a residency for the third year running. We host 200 students and 35-40 faculty at Green Mountain, and the Balourdets have had an outsized impact on our community with their visits in 2022 and 2023. The quartet's career was already on a steep upward trajectory at the time of their first visit in 2022, but many in our community had not yet encountered the group. Their electrifying performances ensured that everyone who was in the audience will be following this group for the rest of their career. The imagination, commitment, and visceral excitement they brought to their performances of Beethoven Opus 130 and 131 will stay with our students for a lifetime.

As spectacular as their performances were, the Balourdets thoroughly won the hearts of our students with their teaching work during their residencies. The quartet held open rehearsals, sharing their painstaking daily Bach chorale warm-up routine, outlining a step-by-step explanation about how they approached rehearsing the Grosse Fugue, and sharing anecdotes about their ups and downs in their journey as a quartet and as individuals. Quartet members went into separate rooms and coached a total of 28 string quartets each year, with students ranging in age from 14-30. Student feedback praised their meticulous attention to detail, probing musical insight, and practical ensemble advice. More intangibly, our students were touched and inspired by how relatable the Balourdets were—open about their struggles, down-to-earth as people, easy to connect with as generational peers.

The opportunity to host a group of this caliber was a great privilege for our festival. I believe they have unique gifts to offer as performers and teachers!"
